

**Notice of Special  
Town Meeting of Electors  
Town of Fredonia, Ozaukee County**

**Wednesday, November 17, 2021 at 7:30pm following a Public Hearing on the proposed  
2022 Budget**

Notice is hereby given that a special town meeting of the Town of Fredonia, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, will be held in the town at Fredonia Government Center, 242 Fredonia Ave, Fredonia, WI on the 17th day of November, 2021. The town elector meeting will be held immediately following the completion of the Public Hearing on the proposed 2022 town budget which begins at 7:00pm., following the regularly scheduled Town Board Meeting, for the following purposes:

1. To consider the adoption of a resolution authorizing the Town Board to make the following donations in the year 2020, pursuant to St. Stats. 60.10(3)9b) & 60.23(3):
  - a) \$7500 to the National Flag Day Foundation to help fund the foundation's civic activities
  - b) \$500 to the Ozaukee County Economic Development Corp.
2. To consider the adoption of a resolution authorizing the Town Board to make the following donations in the year 2020, pursuant to St. Stats. 60.10(3)(e) & 60.23(16):
  - a) \$1000 to the Random Lake Cemetery Association to help fund cemetery maintenance, and
  - b) \$1000 to the St. Paul's Evangelical Congregation Cemetery Association, d/b/a the Waubeka Community Cemetery to help fund cemetery maintenance
3. To consider the adoption of Resolution 2021-09 endorsing Town Board Resolution 2021-07, which proposes that the town levy exceed the state allowable levy limit under s. 66.0602 of Wis. Statutes, specifically a proposed tax levy which would exceed the allowable town tax levy for 2021 by 5.35 percent which would be a dollar increase of \$31,254 over the allowable levy, and 5.87 percent which would be \$34,110 over the 2020 adjusted levy limit and to set the 2021 total town tax levy to be collected in 2022 at \$615,014 pursuant to s. 60.10(1)(a) of Wis. Statutes.
